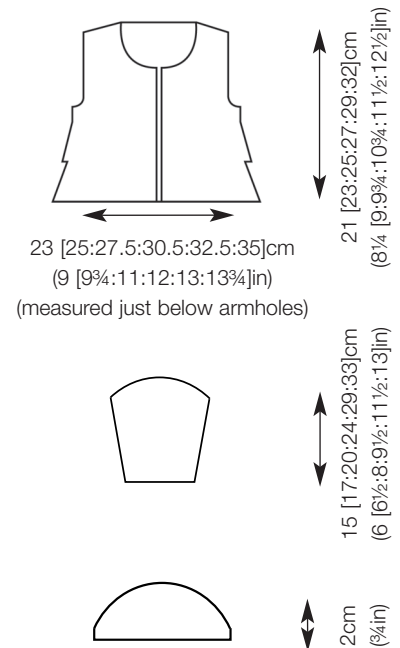

Long Sleeved Cardigan

F075 Snuggly DK

Colour A shade 312	1	1	1	1	2	2	50g balls
Colour B shade 313	1	1	1	1	1	2	50g balls
Colour C shade 251	1	1	2	2	2	2	50g balls

Short Sleeved Cardigan

F075 Snuggly DK

Colour A shade 312	1	1	1	1	2	2	50g balls
Colour B shade 313	1	1	1	1	1	2	50g balls
Colour C shade 350	1	1	1	1	1	1	50g ball

Also suitable for Snuggly Baby Bamboo DK, Snuggly Pearls DK, Snuggly Peekaboo DK, Snuggly Baby Cotton DK and Snuggly Tiny Tots DK. Amounts may vary. The yarn amounts are based on average requirements when specified tension and yarn is used.

You will also need 1 Pair of 4mm (UK8 - USA6) Knitting Needles and 1 Pair of 3¼mm (UK10 - USA3) Knitting Needles. Stitch Holders. 1 Button.

TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm, (4in) over stocking stitch on 4mm needles or the size required to give correct tension.

Check your tension - if less stitches use a thinner needle, if more use a thicker needle.

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

ABBREVIATIONS

alt alternate, **beg** beginning, **cm** centimetres, **cont** continue, **dec** decrease(ing), **DK** double knitting, **fol** following, **g** grammes, **in** inch(es), **inc** increase(ing), **k** knit, **mm** millimetres, **p** purl, **rem** remain(ing), **rs** right side, **st(s)** stitch(es), **tog** together, **ws** wrong side, **yfwd** yarn forward.

Circle the size you wish to make

referred to as **st-st** (stocking stitch). **

LONG SLEEVED CARDIGAN

BACK

Lower Tier

Using 3¼mm needles, thumb method and A cast on 102 [110:122:134:142:154] sts.

1st Row. Knit.

This row will now be referred to as **g-st** (garter stitch).

Work 1 row more in g-st.

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

1st Row. Knit.

2nd Row. Purl.

1st and 2nd rows will now be

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until work measures 10 [11:12:13:14:15]cm, (4 [4¼:4¾:5¼:5½:6]in), ending with a rs row.

Next Row. * P2tog, rep from * to end. 51 [55:61:67:71:77] sts.

Leave rem sts on a stitch holder.

Upper Tier

Using B work as given for Lower tier to **.

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until work measures 5 [6:6:7:7:8]cm, (2 [2½:2½:2¾:2¾:3]in), ending with a rs row.

Next Row. * P2tog, rep from * to end. 51 [55:61:67:71:77] sts.

Join Lower and Upper Tiers

With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles and C, place upper tier in front of lower tier and join together as follows:-

Next Row. (K2tog 1st st of upper tier and 1st st of lower tier), 51 [55:61:67:71:77] times.

51 [55:61:67:71:77] sts.

Work 3 rows in g-st.

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until work measures 11 [12:13:14:15:17]cm, (4¼ [4¾:5¼:5½:

6:6½]in), ending with a ws row.

Shape Armholes

Work 6 [6:6:8:8] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.

39 [43:49:51:55:61] sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 10 [11:12:13:14:15]cm, (4 [4¼:4¾:5¼:5½:6]in), ending with a ws row.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 5 [6:6:7:7:8] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

29 [31:37:37:41:45] sts.

Cast off 6 [6:7:7:7:9] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

17 [19:23:23:27:27] sts.

Cast off rem 17 [19:23:23:27:27] sts.

LEFT FRONT

Lower Tier

Using 3¼mm needles, thumb method and A cast on 52 [56:62:68:72:78] sts.

Work 2 rows in g-st.

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:- **

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until work measures 10 [11:12:13:14:15]cm, (4 [4¼:4¾:5¼:5½:6]in), ending with a rs row.

Next Row. * P2tog, rep from * to end. 26 [28:31:34:36:39] sts.

Leave rem 26 [28:31:34:36:39] sts on a stitch holder.

Upper Tier

Using B work as given for Lower Tier to **.

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until work measures 5 [6:6:7:7:8]cm, (2 [2½:2½:2¾:2¾:3]in), ending with a rs row.

Next Row. * P2tog, rep from * to end. 26 [28:31:34:36:39] sts.

Join Lower and Upper Tiers

With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles and C, place upper tier in front of lower tier and join together as follows:-

Next Row. (K2tog 1st st of upper tier and 1st st of lower tier), 26 [28:31:34:36:39] times.

26 [28:31:34:36:39] sts.

Work 3 rows in g-st.

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until work measures 11 [12:13:14:15:17]cm, (4¼ [4¾:5¼:5½:6:6½]in), ending with a ws row. ***

Shape Armhole and Neck

Next Row. K2tog (armhole edge), knit to last 2 sts, k2tog (neck edge). 24 [26:29:32:34:37] sts.

Next Row. Purl to last 2 sts, p2tog. 23 [25:28:31:33:36] sts.

Work 4 [4:4:6:6:6] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in every row AT SAME TIME dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row.

17 [19:22:22:24:27] sts.

Work 4 [6:12:8:12:12] rows dec 1 st at neck edge only in next and every foll alt row.

15 [16:16:18:18:21] sts.

Work 13 [13:9:13:13:13] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll 4th row.

11 [12:13:14:14:17] sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 10 [11:12:13:14:15]cm, (4 [4¼:4¾:5¼:5½:6]in), ending with a ws row.

Shape Shoulder

Next Row. Cast off 5 [6:6:7:7:8] sts, knit to end. 6 [6:7:7:7:9] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Cast off rem 6 [6:7:7:7:9] sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as given for Left Front to ***.

Shape Neck and Armhole

Next Row. K2tog (neck edge), knit to last 2 sts, k2tog (armhole edge). 24 [26:29:32:34:37] sts.

Next Row. P2tog, purl to end. 23 [25:28:31:33:36] sts.

Work 4 [4:4:6:6:6] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row AT SAME TIME dec 1 st at armhole edge in every row.

17 [19:22:22:24:27] sts.

Work 4 [6:12:8:12:12] rows dec 1 st at neck edge only in next and every foll alt row.

15 [16:16:18:18:21] sts.

Work 13 [13:9:13:13:13] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll 4th row.

11 [12:13:14:14:17] sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 10 [11:12:13:14:15]cm, (4 [4¼:4¾:5¼:5½:6]in), ending with a rs row.

Shape Shoulder

Next Row. Cast off 5 [6:6:7:7:8] sts, purl to end. 6 [6:7:7:7:9] sts.

Next Row. Knit.

Cast off rem 6 [6:7:7:7:9] sts.

LONG SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 3¼mm needles, thumb method and C cast on 31 [31:33:33:37:39] sts work 2 rows in g-st. Change to 4mm needles and working in st-st (throughout) inc 1 st at each end of 3rd and every foll 10th [4th:4th:6th:8th:8th] row to 39 [37:37:39:43:45] sts.

For 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only

Inc 1 st at each end of every foll [6th:6th:8th:10th:10th] row to [45:49:49:53:57] sts.

For all 6 sizes

Cont without shaping until sleeve measures 15 [17:20:24:29:33]cm, (6 [6½:8:9½:11½:13]in), or length required, ending with a ws row.

Shape Sleeve Top

Work 6 [6:6:8:8:8] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.
27 [33:37:33:37:41] sts.
Cast off 3 [4:3:3:3:3] sts at beg of next 6 [6:6:2:8:4] rows.
9 [9:19:27:13:29] sts.

For 3rd, 4th and 6th sizes only

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next [2:4:4] rows. [11:11:13] sts.

For all 6 sizes

Cast off rem 9 [9:11:11:13:13] sts.

SHORT SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 3¼mm needles, thumb method and C cast on 39 [45:49:53:57:61] sts.

Work 2 rows in g-st.

Change to 4mm needles and working in st-st (throughout) proceed as follows:-

Next Row. K4 [4:6:5:3:5], k2tog, (k8 [5:10:4:5:5], k2tog) 3 [5:3:7:7:7] times, k3 [4:5:4:3:5].
35 [39:45:45:49:53] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Work 2 rows more in st-st.

Shape Sleeve Top

Work 6 [6:6:8:8:8] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.
23 [27:33:29:33:37] sts.
Cast off 2 [2:1:1:1:2] sts at beg of next 10 [10:4:4:4:14] rows.
3 [7:29:25:29:9] sts.

For 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next [10:8:10] rows. 9 sts.

For all 6 sizes

Cast off rem 3 [7:9:9:9:9] sts.

RIGHT FRONT BORDER

Join shoulder seams. Sew upper tier in position to lower tier at front edge.

With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles and C, pick up and knit 2 sts evenly along g-st, 14 [16:16:17:19:20] sts evenly along front edge of lower tier to beg of upper tier 14 [14:17:18:20:21] sts evenly along front edge of upper tier working through double thickness of upper and lower tier, 4 sts evenly along straight edge of yoke, 27 [30:31:33:37:39] sts evenly along shaped edge and 8 [9:11:11:13:13] sts evenly to centre back of neck.

69 [75:81:85:95:99] sts.

1st Row. Knit.

2nd Row. K30 [32:35:37:41:43], k2tog, yfwd, knit to end.

Work 2 rows more in g-st.

Cast off knitways.

LEFT FRONT BORDER

With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles and C, starting at centre back of neck, pick up and knit 8 [9:11:11:13:13] sts evenly from back of neck, 27 [30:31:33:37:39] sts evenly along shaped edge, 4 sts evenly along straight edge of yoke, 14 [14:17:18:20:21] sts evenly along front edge of upper tier working down and through double thickness of upper and lower tier, 14 [16:16:17:19:20] sts evenly along front edge of lower tier and 2 sts evenly along g-st.
69 [75:81:85:95:99] sts.

Work 4 rows in g-st.

Cast off knitways.

TO MAKE UP

Fold sleeves in half lengthways, then placing folds to shoulder seams, sew sleeves in position. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on button. Pin out garment to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
